NOTE FOR CANDIDATES

1. Those candidates who did not update their qualifying examination marks on the NIPER website within the prescribed window, and whose status of qualifying exam is still “Appearing”, and have not submitted/uploaded Annexure II specified in Notification are not eligible to participate in counseling.
2. Those candidates who are not qualified in NIPER JEE 2020 are not eligible to participate in counseling.
3. There will be only two rounds of counseling and Upgradation will be permitted in the first rounds only.
4. **The Eligibility, Qualifications for Admission to different Courses has been notified in the point no. 3 in PhD Information Brochure.**
5. In case any degree from a particular college/university is not considered for admission by any allocated NIPER or any particular college/university has been derecognized by UGC, or due to any court directives (present or future), the admission of such students shall be liable to be cancelled
6. Candidates declared eligible for registration and choice filling are advised to remain in regular touch with NIPER website www.niperahm.ac.in or www.niperjee.in for any change in schedule/notices/circulars, etc. In case the SMS/e-mail are issued and not received by the candidates in time due to technical reason(s), NIPER-A shall not be held responsible for it.

1. NIPER JEE 2020 AND ONLINE COUNSELING

National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research Joint Entrance Examination -2020 was conducted by NIPER Ahmedabad on 28.09.2020 for admission to different courses in Master of Science Program, Master of Business Administration (Pharm. Management), and PhD Programs running across 7 NIPERs in the country. Under the aegis of Department of Pharmaceuticals, Govt of India.

Based upon rank of candidates in the All India Merit List and availability of seat in a particular Course/Programme opted in the desired NIPER, the seats shall be allocated to the qualified candidates.

2. NIPER-WISE AND COURSE-WISE NUMBER OF SEATS AVAILABLE FOR ADMISSION

The seat matrix based on the seats received from different NIPERs are given in **Annexure I**

3. ADMISSION THROUGH ONLINE COUNSELING

- (i) Based on the overall merit/rank, the candidate is allowed to take admission in a specific programme at any NIPER as per his/her choice and the availability of seat at that merit rank through the process of counseling as explained here under. In the matter of allotment/admission of candidates to respective NIPERs, the decision of the JCC/NIPER A competent authority shall be final. Once a candidate accepts admission/joins any NIPER, he/she will be a bonafide student of that NIPER (subject to the verification of his/her Original documents/certificates at the time of physical reporting to the allocated NIPER and thereafter,& will be governed by all the academic rules/regulations including migration, as applicable at that NIPER. NIPER A will not entertain any direct request from the candidates in any such matters thereafter.
- (ii) Once recommendation for admission is finalized, change in the placement of course/programme/NIPER or transfer/migration would not be permissible under any circumstances. NIPER A will have no responsibility for change of course/programme/NIPER after the counseling. No correspondence in this respect

will be entertained.

- (iii) In case, at any stage, the documents submitted by the candidate are found to be fake/forged, admission of the candidate will be forfeited and he/she shall be liable for consequential legal action. No refund of fees is applicable in any circumstances.
- (iv) If the admitting NIPER is not satisfied with the character, past behavior or antecedents of a candidate, it can refuse to admit him/her. NIPER-A has no role in such decision.
- (v) Any external pressure/canvassing by the candidate for admission will be treated as disqualification and his/her admission will be cancelled forthwith.

METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION

Method of Selection

- (i) The candidates declared/notified as eligible for counseling, based on their merit-rank, shall register for online counseling as per counseling instructions given hereunder. Candidate shall forfeit the claim for admission if he/she, does not register for counseling within the specified date and time. **A candidate who has not been declared/notified as eligible for counseling, shall not be considered for admission in any NIPER.**
- (ii) Candidate will be recommended for admission in the Course/programme at the NIPER on the basis of merit and availability of seats at his/her merit rank at the time of online counseling.
- (iii) The candidates must complete the post graduate degree in all respects and should have all the degree- completion requirements on the date of Counseling or he should have submitted & uploaded the affidavit of this concern failing which they will not be considered for admission. Please note that **NIPERs will NOT be held responsible for denial of admission to non-eligible candidates.**
- (iv) List of original documents with self-attested photocopies, photographs to be produced at the time of reporting in the allotted NIPER: **(Refer details listed)**

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

The candidates will be required to submit the following documents in original and a set of photocopies of these certificates at the time of reporting at the allotted NIPER (if any). failing which, the candidature shall be summarily rejected:

2. Proof of date of birth Certificate/ Matriculation Certificate as a proof of age and correct name.
 3. Mark sheets of all the semesters' years of qualifying degree.
 4. Admit Card of NIPER online test.
 5. **Original Migration Certificate (Last University/ Institute Attended)**
 6. GPAT/GATE/NET Card wherever applicable.
 7. Award letter (if any) of NET-JRF of CSIR/UGC/DBT/ICMR, DST etc.
 8. Caste certificate, if applicable.
 9. Certificate of disability, if applicable.
 10. Medical Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner of a Government Hospital to be provided in the format given at Annexure-1.
 11. Sponsorship certificate from the employer in case of Government/Industry sponsored candidates as per form attached at Annexure-2.
 12. Affidavit to be provided by the candidate against ragging in the format provided at Annexure-3
 13. Undertaking to be given by the parents of the candidate. Format provided at Annexure-4.
 14. Affidavit to be provided by the candidate as per the format provided at Annexure-8.
- (Candidates are requested to refer prescribed annexure formats mentioned in PhD information Brochure at www.niperahm.ac.in).**

Candidates reporting for the admission in the allotted NIPER should have final year/final semester result in hand clearly indicating final OGPA/CGPA or final percentage of marks where grade points are not awarded. However if candidate doesn't have his mark sheet due to non declaration of result or non conduct of final semester/year examinations he/she has to submit it before commencement of first term examinations & **he will not be given any fellowship till he produces his final grade card / mark sheet as per the minimum qualification prescribed in the prospectus of NIPERJEE 2020.**

All the results/permission to appear in online counseling of NIPER JEE 2020 are provisional and are subject to final production of original documents at the time of reporting at the allotted NIPER (if any).

Admission through Online Counseling

Applying for NIPER JEE-2020, and appearing in the examination & personal interview and qualifying the same does not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility. The applicant for a particular course must satisfy the eligibility criteria as specified in the NIPER JEE 2020 Information Brochure (or its amendments/corrections) available on NIPER website (www.niperahm.ac.in, www.niperjee.in). **The eligibility of the candidate for the provisional admission is verified based upon the uploaded**

documents only. However the admission on allotted seats would be confirmed by respective NIPERs after verification with original documents.

In case the candidate is found not eligible at any stage, his/her candidature would be summarily rejected and admission will be cancelled.

There will be online counseling only. The candidates declared eligible for counseling for the consideration of admission to the NIPER would be generally larger than the number of seats available, provided they have minimum cut off marks to be decided by Competent Authority (JCC) to get the sufficient number of candidates for counseling and filling of all the seats. as per Supreme Court directives in this regard.

Mere qualifying NIPER JEE2020 does not entitle a candidate to claim admission.

Online Counseling Process

- (i) The candidates declared eligible for online counseling, will have to get registered by paying non- refundable advance fee of **Rs. 750/- for SC/ST & RS 1500/- for Gen & OBC** through online payment gateway by using Credit/Debit card/Net banking. This fee shall be adjusted with your fees incase your admission is confirmed . however the advance fee will not be refunded in any case even if, you don't take admission to allotted seat or no seat is allotted to you in the counseling.
- (ii) No correspondence from the candidates/guardians/parents will be entertained by the NIPER A for seeking permission for late registration/admission in the NIPERs or issuing any direction in this regard.
- (iii) Only the registered & qualified candidates will be able to log on to online counseling portal. He/she will be able to access the website from any place of his/her convenience like mobile/home/office, etc.
- (iv) If the candidate does not remember his/her login ID and password, then the login ID/password will be recoverable by input of some personal parameters.
- (v) Details of available seat matrix , process of Online counseling, helpline numbers will be available on the home page of the portal.
- (vi) The candidates qualified in the entrance examination shall be permitted to make choice of Courses/NIPERs in stipulated time period.
- (vii) Candidates will have access to select various choices based upon their qualification and eligibility and seat availability in that category. Similarly, list of only those NIPERs will be displayed where the desired programme by the candidate is offered.

- (viii) Candidate will be able to select the courses and the NIPERs one by one. Only those subjects for which the candidate is eligible. There will be provision to add/modify/delete choices during the stipulated time period. Further, provision for interchange/upward movement/downward movement will also be available and permissible any number of times.
- (ix) The procedure for exercising choices or seeking other information will be menu-driven and guide the candidates through appropriate messages on the computer screen.
- (x) After completion of choice selection, the candidate will save the choices. He/she will be able to take a draft printout, with lock status, so that he/she can discuss the choices filled-with his/her mentors and update the same, if desired.
- (xi) Candidate can update his/her choices any number of times before the last date /until the choices are locked by the candidate. If by the last date and time, the choices are not locked by the candidate, then the last saved choices will automatically be locked by the system.
- (xii) Login ID will be provided to all the accredited NIPERs to provide access to the online counseling portal. The NIPERs would be able to see the number and details of candidates who have chosen a particular course as their first/second/third choice, etc.
- (xiii) The locked choices shall be processed through automated system according to merit and available seats on a scheduled date for the allotment of seats. The candidates will be intimated through e-mail/SMS about the NIPERs and Course allotted. The list of allotted candidates will be updated in the relevant database.
- (xiv) All the candidates who have been allotted a seat for the first time in any round of allotment will be mandatorily required to submit the fees online within the prescribed date and time, failing which their allotment will be cancelled. The NIPERs will check online details of provisional admission offer (from NIPER) downloadable by the candidates for verification. After depositing of requisite fee by the candidates, NIPER A will issue **the final provisional admission letter** to the admitted candidates.
- (xv) Subsequent round of online counseling will be conducted immediately after the reporting is complete. The Upgradation (requests, which can be availed only after confirming the seat by fee payment however if the student do not pay the fee,

he/she would be out from the next round of counseling & seat will fall vacant for other registered candidate) shall be tried first to give the candidates their better choice. Then, the next round shall be started.

- (xvi) Thereafter, the same process for subsequent round of counseling will be followed.
- (xvii) Candidate, not fulfilling the eligibility condition(s) at the time of admission in the allotted NIPER, except presenting the final year marksheet/grade card will forfeit claim for admission and will not be considered for seat allocation. Candidature in such cases shall be rejected summarily. No correspondence shall be entertained thereafter in this regard.
- (xviii) In case a candidate has been admitted in any course at any NIPER, after the counseling, any request for change/transfer of course/NIPER will not be entertained by NIPER A. The candidate, once admitted in a degree programme as per his/her choice, merit-rank and availability of seat at the time of counseling, will not stake claim for change of subject/NIPER later on after his/her admission is over.
- (xix) All admitted candidates will be required to submit original certificates and mark sheets to the Registrar of the allotted NIPER, otherwise admission may not be granted. All original certificates submitted by the candidates may be sent by the allotted NIPER to their respective Boards and Universities for verification.
- (xx) If any candidate fails to deposit the prescribed admission fee and original certificates as required by the NIPER, the admission may be discontinued and candidate would forfeit his/her claim for admission.
- (xxi) In case, after depositing the admission fee at the time of counselling, the candidate wants to forego his admission due to certain reasons, then, in such cases, NO refund of fee would be considered as per NIPER Policy.

UPGRADATION

After the first round of allotment, some candidates may be allotted their 2nd/3rd/4th or subsequent choice. On the other hand, some seats allotted to other candidates may remain vacant due to non-payment of fees the seat(s) have become vacant, these candidates may request for sliding to a better choice in the subsequent round of allotment. However, the candidate will be considered for sliding ONLY to one of the better choices that were given by him/her at the time of online choice filling. Such candidates should online mark themselves for “Upgradation”. However, it will be

MANDATORY for the candidate to first take admission on the allotted seat by paying the prescribed fee.

Candidate will be able to do “Up gradation”, after depositing the remaining fee and confirming his seat, as per his/her convenience at home, using his/her login credentials. Such candidates will be required to print their “Up gradation” letter. Vice versa, if the candidate had opted for “Up gradation” after depositing the fees but does not want to continue with it, then he/she will be able to do so through his/her individual login as per his/her convenience at home. The status of all the candidates who had opted for “Up gradation”, will be available through NIPERs Login.

In the subsequent round of allotment, such candidates will be tried first for their better choices on the seats which had become vacant due to non reporting, ineligibility, etc. If the candidate does not get a better choice, then his/her initially allotted seat will be retained by him/her. If the candidate gets a better choice, then his/her initially allotted seat will stand forfeited and the candidate will have to accept the “Upgraded” seat. In no case, such “Upgraded” candidate will be allowed to retain the initially allotted seat. Therefore, the candidate must be very careful in exercising the request for “Upgradation”. The “Upgraded” candidates need not to deposit the fees again. After upgradation, the candidate should contact the concerned NIPER and verify the date of registration and additional requirements/criteria, if any, for the allotted course, well in advance, before finally reporting for admission.. At the time of beginning of Classes at the NIPER, documents of all candidates will be checked later and in the event of lapses being found, the NIPER may cancel admission of such candidates. In reporting module of the NIPER login, all such candidates will be marked as “Admitted” by default by the system. The NIPER will not be able to change their status as Not Admitted: Absent/Not turned up. If a candidate is “Upgraded” during the second allotment and he/she still has scope of getting a better choice, then he/she can again request for “Upgradation”.

Since there will be only three rounds of counseling, request for “Upgradation” will be permissible only during the first round. Subsequent round of allotments (2nd) will be conducted for candidates who did not get any seat in the earlier rounds. However, their choices will remain the same as filled in the beginning if seats remain vacant.

Procedure/Major steps involved in Online Counselling & Upgradation for NIPER JEE 2020 have been outlined at Annexure-IV.

4.0 LEGAL JURISDICTION

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of Online Counseling for admission to Masters degree programmes shall fall within the jurisdiction of GANDHINAGAR Courts only. As per Rules and Bye-laws of NIPER.

ONLINE CHOICE FILLING (AS PER DECLARED SCHEDULE)



Candidates found eligible for counseling will be sent Username and Password through email and/or SMS on the registered email ID/Mobile No.



Candidate should visit the website www.niperahm.ac.in or www.niperjee.in and login using the Username and Password.



Payment of one-time NON-REFUNDABLE advance fee (**Rs 1500/- for Gen & OBC, Rs 750 for SC/ST**) through Online payment gateway.



Selection of preferred Course and the NIPER (from drop down menu) one by one with preference change facility.

(Candidates must ensure that all the eligibility conditions, as specified in the NIPER JEE 2020 Information Brochure available on NIPERA website (www.niperahm.ac.in or www.niperjee.in) are fulfilled



Choice filling will be permitted only once. For subsequent round(s) of counselling, allotment will be done on the basis of same choices (If the candidate has not been allotted any seat till then.)



Only those course(s) will be displayed for which the candidate is eligible. For Ph.D.subject (opted at the time of online application) will be displayed

Candidate should fill maximum number of choices but give utmost importance to the preference/order/serial number of his/her choices as this will be an important criterion for seat allotment.

Candidates MUST “lock” their choices on/before the last day of choice filling. If candidates do NOT lock their choices, last saved choices will be locked automatically upon reaching the deadline for choice filling.

Candidates will NOT be allowed to edit their choice list after the deadline for choice filling, i.e. candidates CANNOT change the order of their choices OR add any more course in OR delete any course from their choice list after the deadline for choice filling.

SEAT ALLOTMENT AND UPGRADATION

On the date of allotment, candidate's choices, his/her merit, qualification, domicile, category and seat matrix will be processed together and seat will be allotted following the reservation rules of GoI. Candidate will be allotted one of his/her desired NIPER/Course.

Candidate should download his/her provisional allotment letter mentioning the Course/University allotted and the dates by which he/she has to deposit the requisite fee. Candidate will also be sent this intimation through SMS and email

All the candidates who have been allotted a seat for the first time in any round of allotment will be mandatorily required to deposit the requisite fee within the prescribed date and time failing which their allotment will be cancelled.

Some candidates will be allotted their 2nd/3rd/4th or even higher choice. On the other hand, some seats allotted to other candidates may remain vacant due to non-reporting or the reasons of ineligibility, etc. Provided the seat(s) have become vacant, these reporting candidates may request for sliding to a better choice in the subsequent round of allotment. It may be clearly noted that the candidate will be considered for sliding ONLY to one of the better choices that were given by him/her at the time of online choice filling. Such candidates should online mark themselves for “Upgradation”. However, it will be MANDATORY for the candidate to first take admission on the allotted seat.

In the subsequent round of allotment, such candidates will be tried first for their better choices on the seats which had become vacant due to not paying the fee.

↓
If the candidate does not get a better choice, then his/her initially allotted seat will be retained by him/her.

↓
If the candidate gets a better choice, then his/her initially allotted seat will stand **CANCELLED and the candidate will have to accept the “Upgraded” seat**. In NO case, such “UPGRADED” candidate will be allowed to retain the initially allotted seat. Therefore, the candidate must be very careful in exercising the request for “Upgradation”.

↓
The “Upgraded” candidates need not to deposit the fees again.

↓
If a candidate is “Upgraded” during the second allotment and he/she still has scope of getting a better choice, then he/she can again request for “Upgradation”. Since the candidate is exempted from depositing the fee as he has already deposited it after 1st allotment so he/she will again be permitted to do so with his/her own login as per his/her convenience at home.

↓
Since there will be only three rounds of counseling, request for “Upgradation” will be permissible only during the first and second rounds.

↓
Subsequent round of allotments (2nd and 3rd) will be conducted for candidates who have not been allotted any seat in the earlier rounds. However, their choices will remain the same as filled in the beginning.

↓
Upon reporting at the allotted NIPER, the candidate has to produce all the relevant original documents to the officials for verification. NIPER may refuse admission if the listed documents are not found in order before the commencement of first term examinations or the candidate is found ineligible for admission. NIPER-A will not be a part of any such decision, taken by respective NIPERs
