

## NIPER JEE 2020 – Steps to change City Preference

As the exam was rescheduled to 28-Sep-2020 due to ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, we are providing ONE-TIME facility to change the Exam City Preferences for your convenience.

This process is NOT mandatory. Follow the below steps for doing the needful, if required :-

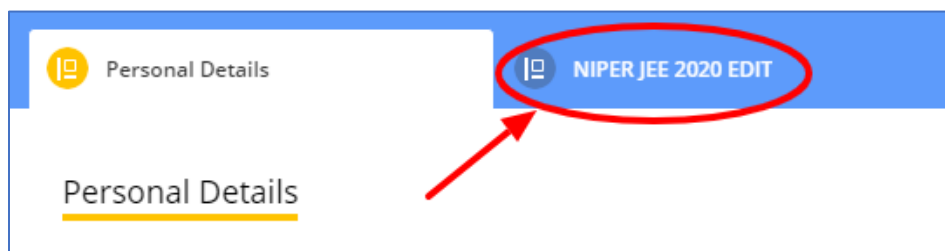
1. Go to NIPER JEE 2020 Candidate Login page :

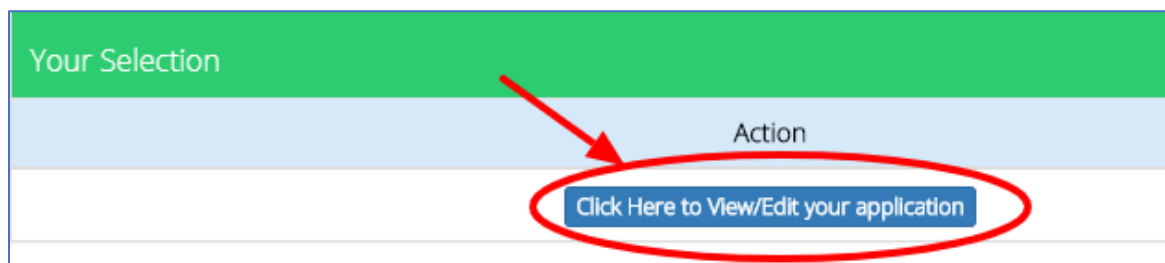
2. Login using your Application Number/User ID and Password.

You can use “Forgot Password” option if you have misplaced your credentials.


3. Click on “NIPER JEE 2020 EDIT” Tab.
